GCCS—Severe Weather Plan

The district will post on their website, social media site and they will notify the local news channels of any delays or cancelations. Please do not call the school office or school employees because it ties up the phone lines which are needed for emergency communications.

A school messenger notification will be sent regarding a delay or closing of school during inclement weather by 6:00 a.m. In the event that school is delayed and weather conditions deteriorate, an announcement to close schools will be made by 8:00a.m. A recorded message will also be available at 812-288-4802 extension 501 or check the GCCS website at www.gcs.k12.in.us.
